

WALTER BLYTHE KELLERMANN

1902 - 1979

Walter Blythe Kellermann, age 77 of 114 N. Main St., Elkton, passed away Wednesday morning, May 23 at Hills and Dales Hospital, Cass City, following an extended illness.

He was born May 19, 1902 in Elkton, where he lived all his life. On August 31, 1926, he and Jennett Furniss were united in marriage in Nashville, Michigan. He owned and operated the Kellermann Shoe Store in Elkton for 20 years until he sold it in 1945. He then started and operated a Farm Equipment Sales until his retirement in 1964. He had served as Township Supervisor for 13 years and also served on the Elkton School Board as treasurer from 1937 to 1942 and as president from 1947 to 1952. Mr. Kellermann was a member of Elkton United Methodist Church, a past member of the Odd Fellows, a charter member of the Elkton Senior Citizens, and a member of the Frank W. Hubbard Masonic Lodge No. 476 F & AM.

He is survived by his wife, Jennett; one son, Raymond of Rockford, Ill; one daughter, Mrs. Darlene Moore of Manton and eight grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Saturday, May 26 at 1 p.m. from the Champagne Funeral Chapel, Elkton. The Rev. Joel Hurley, pastor of the Elkton United Methodist Church, officiated with burial in Riverside Cemetery, Elkton.
