Starting January 1^{st} , 2016, LBV Maintenance Assessment rates will increase. For <u>Improved</u> lots the change will be from \$96 to \$160 per year. For <u>Unimproved</u> lots the change will be from \$96 to \$112 per year.

These changes will be reflected in your 2016 statement, which will be mailed to you on or about December 16th, and will be due on January 1st, 2016, payable no later than January 15th (<u>not</u> February 15th).
