ABOUT THE 2019 MUNICIPAL ELECTION

When voters go to the polls this November, they will be given two paper ballots. Click on your Township/Borough and Precinct to see samples.

The first ballot will contain the races for the Pike County Row offices, Township and Borough offices and School Board Directorships for Delaware Valley, East Stroudsburg Area and Wallenpaupack Area. In addition to these races, the ballot will also show races for two Pennsylvania Superior Court Judges, Pike County Court of Common Please Judge and District Magisterial races, as well as a ballot question which would lead to an amendment of the Pennsylvania Constitution.

The second ballot will ask voters to decide whether or not two judges each sitting on the Pennsylvania Commonwealth Court and Pennsylvania Superior Court should retain their seats for another term. The votes in this case are either "yes" or "no". Both of these sample ballots can be viewed per township or borough by clicking the button above.
