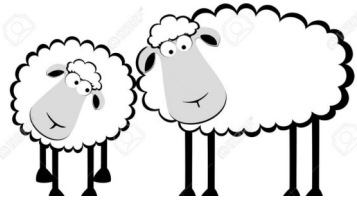

# One Shepherd's Thoughts...

During the new year, I want to teach you about being Disciples in the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). I want to share some of our history—some of our thinking—some of our ways of being Disciples...

By virtue of membership in a recognized local congregation, a Disciple also holds membership in the region where the congregation is located. There are 36 geographical units, called regions, within the Christian Church (Disciples of Christ). Each are charged with functions under the broad categories of mission and nurture; (this number is changing as some regions are joining together into one). Regional *mission* includes leading in the development of a sensitive comprehension of human needs beyond the congregation, leading in the discovery of new forms of ministerial witness, and leading in the pursuit of ecumenical means to fulfill mission. Regional *nurture* responsibilities are more specific and include certifying the standing of ministers, providing pastoral care for ministers and congregations, overseeing the process of ordination and relocation of ministers, and assisting each congregation to relate to the general manifestation.



Each region, like each congregation, reserves certain rights, such as constituting its own board, bylaws, and budget; owning its own property; calling its ministerial staff; and being represented in the process of developing the corporate judgments of the total church.

I recently worked on the rewriting of the Florida Region bylaws and currently serve as the Moderator Elect for the Florida Regional Leadership Council (Board).
