- 4. Be able to provide a class schedule or registration prior to receiving funds.
- 5. Submit completed application **postmarked** by **March 25** to the ECC at PO Box 3904, Evergreen, CO 80437. *No late or incomplete applications will be considered.*

RESUME: Please submit a resume highlighting your extracurricular activities, experiences, and achievements. Include choral, vocal, theatrical, dance, instrumental, and art education, experience, and accomplishments. Also include outside activities such as community service work, job experience, club involvement, leadership positions held, honors received, personal interests, etc. Portfolios may also be included.

LETTERS: Submit two letters of recommendation from two adults other than your parents. The letters should be confidential and include how they know you and why they think you would be a deserving recipient of this scholarship. Be sure they include their address, phone number, and how long they have known you. Have each person seal the envelope, sign it across the seal, and give it to you to include with your application.

TRANSCRIPTS: Submit an official transcript. You may attach your personal comments on a separate page addressing your reasons for course selections, explanations, or other comments.

QUESTIONAIRE: Answer the following questions limiting yourself to 200 words for each question.

- 1. What skills did you take from Evergreen Children's Chorale that have benefited you in your High School years?
- **2.** How do you intend to keep the arts alive in your future?
- 3. Why should you be awarded this scholarship?
