1.9	2.1	L	Hwy 441 S @ SS CAUTION: Watch for trucks/Rumble strips
0.2	2.3	R	Cross Justice Rd.
1.8	4.1	R	George Hatcher Rd.
2.4	6.5	R	JR Sims Rd. @ SS @T-intersection.
4.6	11.1	S	Hwy 57 @ Flashing red light. Continue straight. Road becomes Old Macon Rd.
0.9	12.0	-	McIntyre city limits
0.1	12.1	-	CAUTION: Sharp curve to left then downhill. WATCH FOR TRUCKS!
0.9	13.0	L	CAUTION: Tracks Left turn immediately after tracks.

# BLUE GOOSE SAFETY

1. Ride single file when a car or truck is behind.
2. Never ride more than two abreast, in accordance with Georgia law. Do not be a road hog. Yield to riders trying to pass. Never cross the center line.
3. Ride as far to the right as practicable, except when making a left turn or when going straight at a right-turn only lane.
4. Call out "car back" or "car up" to riders in front.
5. Call out intentions to riders immediately behind: "Slowing", "Stopping", or "Turning". Use traffic hand signals when appropriate.
6. Point to road hazards and/or call out to riders behind: "Gravel". "Hole", "Tracks".
7. Call out to riders as you are about to pass: "On your left." or "Good Morning".  
Never pass on the right.
8. Wear a helmet at all times while on the bike.
9. Obey all traffic signs and signals. Do NOT call out "Clear" at stop signs or red lights.
10. Always ride defensively. Always be aware of other riders, vehicles and pedestrians nearby.  
Never assume you know what they are going to do.
11. Use common sense and courtesy toward motorists and other cyclists while on the bike.
12. Provide immediate adult supervision to any bicycling children under age 16.
13. Do not ride before daylight or after dusk unless fitted with proper lights on the bike, in accordance with Georgia law.
14. When stopping for any reason, get completely off the road.
15. Do not wear headphones while riding the bike.
