A reminder for all Havasu Garden Estates residents in regards to some laws for wildlife & pets in Mohave County:

It is against Mohave County laws to feed wildlife. Wildlife includes wild birds, burrows, rabbits, coyotes, and any other types of wildlife. We've had a number of concerns reported to the board about the excessive amount of rats and raccoons on their property/neighborhood. And that's part of what happens when you feed the wildlife. Coyotes on their own..will jump a fence WHEN they can and WILL catch your cat or your small dog just because they could. Dogs outside your home and not behind your fenced yard must be on leash. We recently had a resident attacked and bitten by an unleashed dog. It does not matter whether the dog is large or small, it must be on a leash.

Speaking of dogs, please carry a poop bag with you when you walk your dog here in Havasu Garden Estates and please pick up their droppings, there and in your "backyard" 'cause who needs all those flies anyway.
