Each Spring they obtain trout eggs from the Pa Fish n Boat and Trout Unlimited partnership, for hatching in classroom aquariums. They then raise them to fingerlings, learning about their life cycle and their environment, learning how watershed conservation and management efforts affect their habitat.


