1919 - 1996

Loren F. Roller, 77 of Fremont, OH, passed away late Tuesday evening, April 30, at his home.

Mr. Roller was born Feb. 3, 1919 in Unionville to Harry and Rosa (Louis) Roller. He was united in marriage to Ruth Bach on Aug. 27, 1949 at Immanuel Lutheran Church, Sabowasing. She survives him.

He graduated from Unionville High School and obtained an associate degree in agriculture from Michigan State University. He served with the Army Air Force during WWII in Quartermaster Corp stationed in the U.S.

Mr. Roller was an area supervisor for H.J. Heinz Company in Michigan until 1988 when he was sent to Fremont where he worked until his retirement in February, 1984. He was a member of St. John Lutheran Church in Fremont.

Surviving besides his wife Ruth are daughters Lenore (Don) Oswald of Angleton, TX, Jan (David) Roller Abbott of Cleveland, and Joy Roller of Washington, DC; a mother, Marie Roller of Sabowasing, sister Alice Gremel of Unionville, and six grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by brothers Demont and LeRoy and a sister, Ruth Gauth. Funeral services were conducted at 3 p.m. Friday, May 3 at St. Paul Lutheran Church in Unionville with burial in Silver Lawn Cemetery in Sabowasing.
