Thinking of Malott's Detroit Marathon description, it occurs that Seetrreon Robinson, a black Olympic hopeful Marathoner (2:21:--), would be a useful critic. Seetreeon, raised in Harlem, is taking the Psychology 560 course and readong Malott and Whalet. Get his reaction to Malott's comments by having him read aloud and then give some reactions. He might need a remedial reading course based on some early performandes int he course.

Towards more Precise Behavioral Language

One of the words I tend to use a lot is purpose. Even with an awareness of the purposivism trap, the word still frequently enters my conversational vocabulary. What are some alternatives? I think "value" and "values" may be one. The value of doing this is... rather than "the purpose of this exercise..." "purpose" still smacks of the future controlling the present, whereas, "value", defined as a person's rewards and punishers, and the strength off those rewards and punishersis consistent with a cause-effect deterministic orientation.
