### A MESSAGE FROM WALK #172 SPIRITUAL DIRECTOR

In 1987 as I was approaching my 39<sup>th</sup> birthday; my oldest child was approaching her 13<sup>th</sup> birthday and my youngest was to turn 10, I found myself in a deep well of depression. First I never thought, I would ever be that old (ha ha, a long time ago), never anticipated my precious babies becoming teenagers, and to be honest from that rut I called my life, I realized I had not become... who I had dreamed... I would be! You see, I had "turned around and faced into my own shadows (in life), and created my own darkness!" Actually a fairly normal thing at that time of life, and then a friend invited to sponsor me on an Emmaus Walk.

On Blue Lake Walk To Emmaus # 12, I learned about Grace; all kinds of Grace. I was given the Grace to re-member, that to God my own darkness, was not dark to God (Psalm 139). At dying moments, when the bread was broken, my eyes were opened and I saw Jesus; and at candlelight I saw a sea of Grace, realizing I wasn't alone. My life has never been the same.

I have had the honor to sponsor others; and been invited to serve on Emmaus teams over the years. On each walk I have watched people become the hands and feet of Jesus. Working hard, getting little sleep (ok maybe no sleep), while paying their own way to do this. On each walk, though I know the whole journey, I am always touched deeply, by the little things our Blessed Lord weaves together, to create the Tapestry that is to become Central Alabama Walk To Emmaus 172.

We have ALL been gathered here, to this one place and time to journey together on this Road To Emmaus. Each one has chosen to be obedient to Jesus' Calling, sharing about "all these things that have taken place in these last few days", for a reason! None of us are here because someone else could not do our part...we are here because as each of us has faced into our shadows; being engulfed by our own darkness; we have discovered that to Jesus it wasn't darkness. Jesus brought the light! Our eyes were opened and we saw Jesus. And because of that, each one of us, holds within the depths of our souls something that one or more of these pilgrims need. And you are the one who has been chosen to share it.

As we journey together, be alert! (whispering) "We will see Jesus and our eyes will be opened" Again! Anew!




