

Jonathan Trask

Jonathan Trask was a Private in Capt. Caleb Low's Company which marched on the alarm of April 19, 1775. He enlisted Aug 25, 1777 in Capt. Samuel Flint's Company, Col. Samuel Johnson's Regiment and was discharged November 30, 1777. Jonathan served at the battle of Saratoga. He received a pension for his service.

Jonathan is buried at the old burying Grounds Lexington, MA. The inscription on his headstone reads:

*Dear Friends
Pray do not weep
I am not dead but here do sleep
Within this solid lump of clay
Until the resurrection day:
And here indeed, I must remain
Till Christ shall raise me up again.*
