"For today in the city of David a savior has been born for you who is Messiah and Lord."



#### A note about Christmas and Holy Family 2021, and Solemnity of Mary 2022

This year, Christmas, December 25th, falls on a Saturday, with the Holy Family on Sunday, December 26th. Here is a handy chart from the Bishop's Committee on Divine Worship to understand what this means for fulfilling the obligation to attend Mass:

Nativity of the Lord (Christmas)	Holy Family	
Obligation may be fulfilled from the evening of Friday, December 24 through Saturday, December 25.	Obligation may be fulfilled from the evening of Saturday, December 25 through Sunday, December 26.	
For example, one may attend:  • Vigil Mass of the Nativity  • Mass during the Night (celebrated at any time)  • Morning/afternoon/evening Masses on December 25	For example, one may attend:  • Afternoon/evening Masses on December 25 (even though the Mass texts will be for the Nativity)  • Morning/afternoon/evening Masses on December 26
