



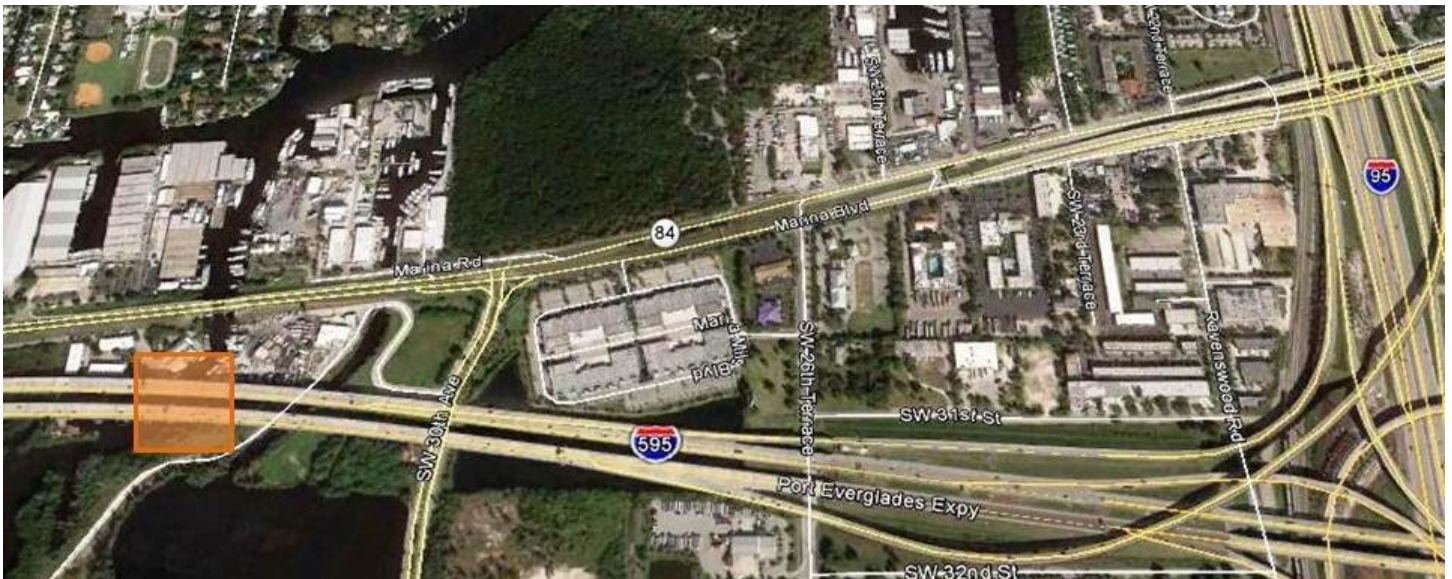
I-595 Bridges Fender System Replacement Project over the South Fork of the New River in Fort Lauderdale

Project Overview

The Florida Department of Transportation has awarded a \$582,300 contract to Sieg and Sons, Inc. to replace the marine fenders and navigation lights underneath the I-595 bridges over the South Fork of the New River in the City of Fort Lauderdale. Construction will begin June 16, 2014 and is expected to be completed by late 2014.

Traffic Impact

Minimal impact is expected to the traveling public during construction. The contractor does not anticipate any construction related lane closures.



Waterway Impact

The contractor will be working from barges and tug boats. Boaters are advised to stay clear of these vessels. Vertical clearance will not be affected by construction activities. The horizontal clearance within the channel will be reduced from 40 feet to 30 feet while crews are working Mondays through Fridays from 7:30 a.m. to 6 p.m. With a 45 minute notice, the barge may be moved to restore the 40 foot clearance.
