Since the July Newsletter, there is a change in District leadership. Deborah Poland has decided to step down from her position as Secretary, but she will remain a PC, SC, & Captain of Cactus Glen Precinct. We appreciate Deborah's contributions as our Secretary since last year and welcome her continuing participation to our ongoing work. I nominated Michele Stephens from Silver Spur Precinct to assume the role of Secretary and that nomination was unanimously approved by the Executive Committee. Michele has extensive experience in political work and is enthusiastic to serve the District and our PCs in this way.
