On January 1, 2007, after many years of being managed by a private foundation, Waterloo Village was turned over to the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Parks and Forestry.

The Division of Parks and Forestry is dedicated to the stewardship of the State's rich and diverse historic, cultural, recreational and natural resources for the benefit of present and future generations.

Since 2007, structural repairs have been made and buildings re-roofed, the Lenape Village has been rebuilt and expanded, and a Preservation Plan was completed.



## Friends of Waterloo Village

In the spring of 2010, a dedicated group of citizens formed Friends of Waterloo Village. Its mission is to work in collaboration with the Division of Parks and Forestry to identify resources and secure funding that will be used specifically for the systemic restoration and continued sustainability of the buildings and structures located in the historic district, which is listed on both the New Jersey and National Register of Historic Places.

Our initial fundraising efforts enabled us to restore the roofs on the Blacksmith Shop, Grist Mill and Mule Barn.
