A resolution which has not been presented through the proper channels will not be considered.

WHEREAS, There is a need to have additional, dedicated Instructors, willing to help teach the program; and

WHEREAS, The current policy of choosing 2 new instructors to receive Leadership Cards each year does not seem to be providing the needed number of instructors, now therefore be it

RESOLVED, That the current program for choosing who will receive a Leadership Instructor Card will be placed on hold for a period of 3 years; and be it further

RESOLVED, That members may apply to become Leadership Instructors utilizing the attached application form, with the final selections made by the Department President, Department Leadership Chairman, and current Leadership Committee; and be it further

RESOLVED, That there will be no limit on how many members may receive a Leadership Instructor's Card in any one year; and be it finally

RESOLVED, That the application method will begin with the next program year (2024-2025) and will be re-evaluated at the end of the 2026-2027 program year for the possibility of making it the permanent policy for choosing Leadership Instructors.
