Mike was truly one of the great guys with whom to play. He was friendly, easy going, and never critical no matter how ill-behaved his fellow golfers might be. Mike and his son, Mike, Jr. were

always contenders in team events, thanks mostly to the senior team member. Mike was modest off the tee but was reliable with his approach shots and superior with his short game. But it was mostly Mike's enjoyment with his playing partners, his genuine pleasure in their accomplishments and his love of the game that made Mike one of our most popular players. Mike also had an outstanding amateur golf career, as shown by some of the hardware on display at his memorial service. Our sincerest condolences are extended to Mike, Jr. and the rest of the Younger family.



Last month I wrote about some historical accomplishments as we celebrate the 40th anniversary of the course and our club. In doing so, I was quickly advised that that the course records were no longer the possessions of our members but in fact belonged to one Andrew Roque. Andrew, who grew up in Fontana and attended La Verne University, shot 61 on both courses in the closing months of 2013. He was a former winner of the Chino Amateur and played on the Canadian Tour with one victory to his credit. Andrew is the owner of 8 course records including a 61 at San Dimas Canyon and a 62 at Brookside, erasing the 63 shot by Tom Weiskopf.

So it has been 40 wonderful years of golf at El Prado and still going strong. Can anyone name our founding President, Treasurer and Social Chairman? A free round of golf goes to the winner (in the event of a tie there will be no winner). The Bill Karsner Memorial was our February tournament in honor of the person who started our Tuesday skins game four decades ago. Two other memorial tournaments (names that we have abandoned over the years due to an onset of Alzheimer's), the Nial Hickman President's Cup and the Ed Malone Red Tee Tournament should serve as clues.
