David E. Dickinson, 71, of Harbor Beach, passed away on Monday, June 9, 2003, in Brian's House of Essexville following a brief illness. Born in Harbor Beach on July 28, 1931, he was the son of Beatrice (Ganley) Dickinson and the late Earl Dickinson. Dave was a veteran of the Korean Conflict serving in the U.S. Navy. He was a retired employee of the City of Harbor Beach serving as the city administrator for 39 years, retiring in 1993.
