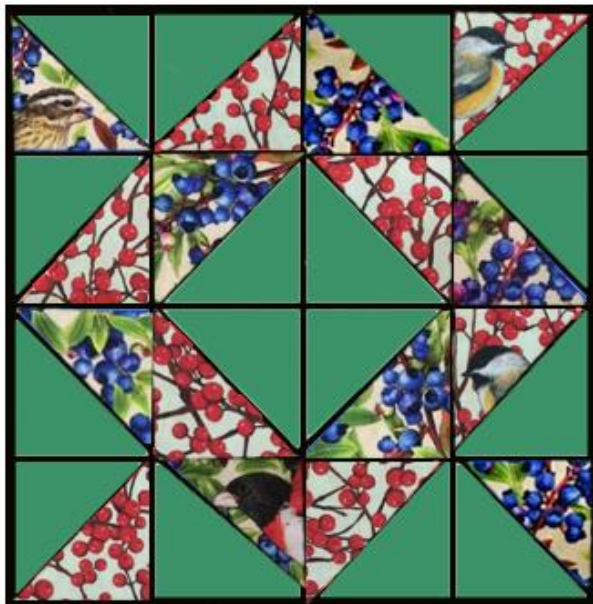


Baxter Park Block by Fa·bri·cate

Finished block size: 12.5" (12" when pieced into your project)



Fabric requirements

Fabric A (Grosbeak & Blueberry)
1/8 yard

Fabric B (Jungle Green blender)
1/8 yard

Fabric C (Chickadee & Winterberry)
1/8 yard

Assembly instructions:

→ Cut **4** 4.25" squares from Fabrics **A** and **C**, and **8** 4.25" squares from Fabrics **B** and **C**.

Hint: try fussy-cutting so that some birds peek into the triangles, as shown above.

→ Make **8** half-square triangles from Fabrics **A + B**, and **8** half-square triangles from Fabrics **B + C**.

Important! Trim all assembled half-square duos to 3.5" square.

Assemble Rows 1-4, as follows; then join horizontally:
