

ORDINANCE NO. 410

An Ordinance Concerning The Use Of Child Restraint Devices
And Safety Belts In Motor Vehicles.

BE IT ORDAINED By The City Council For The City Of Rolla, North Dakota,
that the following Sections of Title 39 of the North Dakota Century Code pertaining to
the use of child restraint devices and safety belts in vehicles be adopted by reference
thereto to the same extent as though set forth fully in this Ordinance. Immediately
following the designation of the State Statute there is set forth the civil penalty to be
imposed for a violation of the referenced offense.

1. 39-21-41.2 Child Restraint Devices \$25.00.
2. 39-21-41.4 Use of Safety Belts Required In Certain Motor Vehicles \$20.00.
3. 39-21-41.5 Secondary Enforcement. A peace officer may not issue a citation for
a violation of section 39-21-41.4 unless the officer lawfully stopped or detained
the driver of the motor vehicle for another violation. Drivers' license points may
not be assessed against any person for violation of section 39-21-41.4.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and take affect immediately upon its final
passage and publication




