Al Fish Goes to Germany US's Volleyball Entry in

diterranean Sports District, TUSLOG, departed here last week for the Kaiserslautern Military Post, Kaiserslautern, Germany, to ready the United States military volleyball team for the CISM (Council of International Sports, Mi-Volleyball World Championships, which will be held December 10-15 in Karachi, Pakistan.

Fish, secretary - treasurer of the US Volleyball Association for the past six years and a member of the Commission of Officials for the International Volleyball Federation, will coach 12-man US team for four weeks at Kaiserslautern.

They will play practice games against both military and national teams, touring France, Luxemburg Belgium, the Netherlands, and Germany.

Selected players are expected at Kaiserslautern from military installations around the world, Fish said, including Japan, Hawaii, the United Kingdom, Europe, and the USA.

This is the third year the US has entered CISM volleyball. France is the defending champion. Ten countries are expected.

Final US team selection will be made by December 5 Fish added, and the team will be airlifted to Karachi by December 7. Matches will be drawn December 9, competition will run December 10-13, with semi-finals scheduled December 14 and finals December 15.

Fish's recent visit to Moscow, Russia, where he was one of eight referees at the Fourth World Volleyball Championships held in the Palace of Sports there, afforded him the opportunity to Alberghetti.

Fish was impressed with the number of teams which have improved their play during the past two years, especially with the Japanese men's team.In 1960 Japan was unable to make the final championship pool. This year they not only qualified, but met the Russian team in the openinig match in Moscow and nearly defeated them, finally losing 3-2 after nearly two hours of grueling play.

«I had the honor of refereeing this match,» Fish said, «and was amazed that smaller Japanese players were able to dominate the strong Russian squad. With two years of playing and coaching before the Olympic Games,
