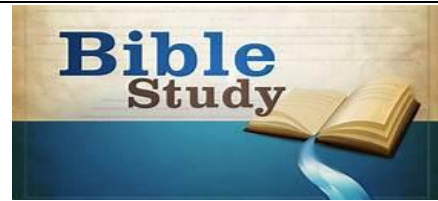

6:30PM - 8:00PM

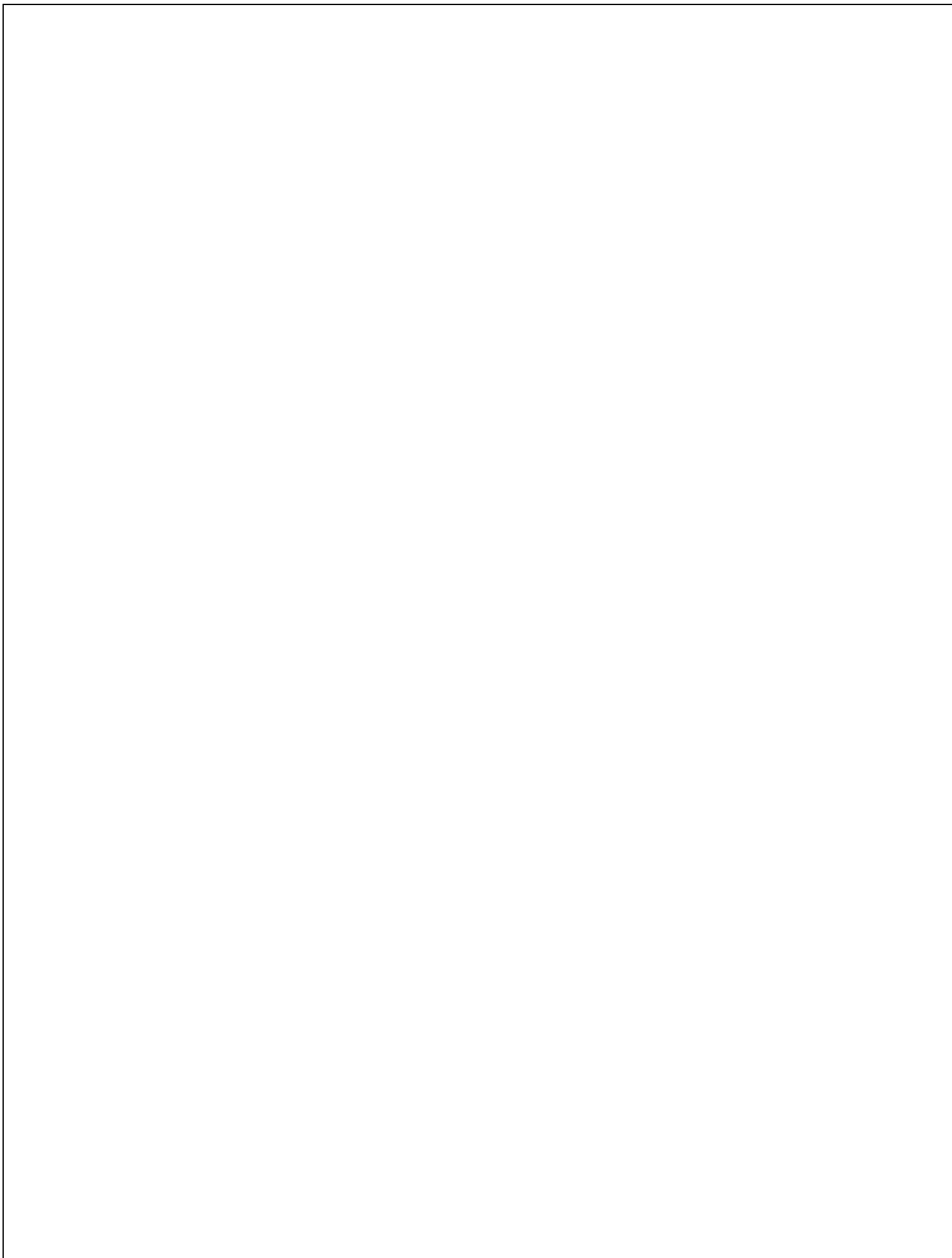
