Qualifications

- Graduated with a high school diploma or GED.
- Minimum of 18 years or older.
- Must be an active member of a church.
- Must meet basic qualifications of TX Health & Human Services [state minimum standards].

Classroom Duties

- Teach from God's word.
- Support and encourage the spiritual well-being of students and parents of your classroom.
- Prepare and implement lesson plans according to the High Hopes Preschool 'Scope & Sequence', DAP, and WEE Learn Curriculum.
- Coordinate lesson plans & daily schedule with co-teacher and Teacher Assistant.
- Provide proper communication to your families, assistant, and administration.
- Develop a positive relationship with families of your classroom through personal contact, cards, phone calls, etc.
- Anything you see that needs to be done within your classroom.
- Maintain a clean room/environment.

Other

- Attendance is required for all special events, and all monthly morning staff meetings and quarterly evenings.
- Complete a minimum of 24 hours of training annually to meet HHS requirement.
