3. Motion made by Mr. Thompson, seconded by Mr. Blocker and carried to accept minutes for June. Mr. Long voted yea, Mr. DeLoach voted yea and Mr. Gordon voted yea.
4. Motion made by Mr. DeLoach, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to accept the denial from the Long County Planning and Zoning to rezone parcel NO. 064 A 019 for Jean and Mary Dorleus. Mr. Long voted yea, Mr. Gordon voted yea and Mr. Blocker voted yea.
5. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to pay half of the lease agreement for the EMS building. The total per month is \$700.00. \$350.00 for the county and \$350.00 for Excelsior Ambulance Service. Mr. Long voted yea, Mr. Gordon voted yea and Mr. DeLoach voted yea.

8. Motion made by Mr. Thompson, seconded by Mr. Blocker and carried to appoint Thelma J. Anderson Worthy to the Long County Board of Elections and Registration for a 4 year term. Mr. Long voted yea, Mr. Gordon voted yea and Mr. DeLoach voted yea.
9. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. DeLoach and carried to accept the RFP proposal from KRT CPAs' in the amount of \$24,500.00 plus mileage. Mr. Long voted yea, Mr. Gordon voted yea and Mr. Thompson opposed.
10. Motion made by Mr. Long, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to accept the 2nd reading and adoption amendment to Long County Timber and Pulpwood Harvesting Ordinance. Mr. Gordon voted yea, Mr. Blocker voted yea and Mr. DeLoach voted yea.
