

Sports Lead Support (Head Counselor) Position - Summer 2021

PENDING STATUS OF COVID-19 and Provincial/Federal Public Health Measures

STATUS: Full-Time (Summer position up to 14 weeks); must be available to attend any mandatory training that may take place prior to employment start date. Employment earliest start date is May 31st, 2021. End date is August 27th, 2021

Summer Sport Programs:

An opportunity for children ages 4-16 to participate in various sports such as softball, basketball and tennis. Program consists of skill development and the importance of good sportsmanship and team work.

Role:

Must be energetic and enjoy working with children and youth in a leadership role. Under the direction of the Recreation Coordinator, the Lead Support will take the lead role in the planning and implementing of our summer sports programs, with a main focus on softball (fast pitch as priority). Duties include being the main contact with Softball Newfoundland, main contact for our volunteer coaches, develop and pick the teams that will represent Goulds at various tournaments, register teams with various softball tournaments. You will also be responsible for the planning and implementation of our house Softball program, our tennis program and basketball program. Duties also include the provision of direct supervision of the sport staff and programs, completing daily/weekly statistics, reports and staff schedules. Maintain a program budget. Ensure the safety of participants and staff. Provide feedback and recommendations on ways to improve or change the programs. The individual must be comfortable and confident in discussing any issues with children, youth, parents/guardians, volunteer coaches and/or staff when required. This position will also be of assistance to the Recreation Coordinator in the area of program planning and implementation.

Qualifications:

All positions are based on approval of government funded summer grants. Some of those grants require positions to be filled by students in either high school or a recognized post-secondary institution or a youth (Student or non-student) between the ages of 15-30.

- Must be a post-secondary student studying in a field related to children/youth (ie. Recreation, Physical Education) or a mature individual with experience working with children/youth (ie. Teacher, Recreation).
- Must have knowledge of the game of softball, specifically fast pitch, and some knowledge of basketball and tennis.
- RNC Certificate of Conduct and Vulnerable Sector Check dated 2021
- Experience in planning and delivering programs for children/youth in a sport setting
- Leadership experience
- Excellent communication skills

- Experience in supervising staff and programs
- Knowledge of child development and behaviour management techniques
- Candidates possessing an equivalent combination of education and experience that is deemed acceptable by Goulds Recreation may be considered.

If not already completed at time of application, the following are qualifications that must be completed prior to employment start date :

- Standard first aid, CPR level C and AED valid certificate
- High Five Principles of Healthy Child Development Certification
- High Five Strengthening Children's Mental Health Certification
