ADS Houston Chapter Scholarship Program 2022 Program Year: Instructions to Applicants (Form A2)

Follow the provided instructions to ensure that your application submittal is complete and all required documentation is provided in order to maximize your potential for winning a scholarship.

Application (Form A1):

1. Fill out the application (Form A1) completely and provide supporting documentation for each item that is requested. Make sure to sign the application. Mail your application and supporting documentation to:

- 2. Make sure that your name and address are shown on the return address portion of the envelope.
- 3. Your application and all supporting documents **must be post-marked by <u>May 31, 2022</u>**. Applications post-marked after May 31, 2022 will not be accepted and will remain un-opened.

Categories of Scholarships:

You may apply under one of the three categories listed:

- 1. Graduating high school senior, planning to attend an accredited university full-time or on a part time basis while full time employed (40 hours per week) in the fall semester of 2022 or the spring semester of 2023.
- 2. University undergraduate student, planning to return to an accredited university full-time or on a part time basis while full time employed (40 hours per week) in the fall semester of 2022 or the spring semester of 2023.
- 3. University graduate student, planning to return to an accredited university full-time or on a part time basis while full time employed (40 hours per week) in the fall semester of 2022 or the spring semester of 2023.

Eligibility Requirements:

To be eligible for consideration for a scholarship from the ADS Houston Chapter, you must meet the following minimum requirements:

- 1. Your completed application and supporting documentation must be mailed or e-mailed to adshouston1@gmail.com no later than May 31, 2022. No applications or other supporting documentation postmarked after May 31, 2022 will be accepted or considered.
- 2. You must be a Houston Chapter member <u>as of the date of your scholarship application submittal</u> and in good standing (i.e. must have paid your membership dues).
- 3. The scholarship (if awarded to you) is to be applied towards the school year period of fall 2022 through spring 2023.

- 4. You must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- 5. You must be in good academic standing (i.e. not on academic probation).
- **6.** You have not been awarded more than three undergraduate ADS Houston Chapter scholarships.
- 7. You have not been awarded more than one graduate ADS Houston Chapter Scholarship.

Document Submittals

All documents required in Form A1 (Scholarship Application) must be submitted with your application.

Communication:

- 1. Application and documents in support of your application must be submitted by US mail or email to adshouston1@gmail.com.
- 2. Any communication between the scholarship applicant and the Scholarship Committee or the Selection Committee must be documented by e-mail. All questions or communication from the applicant must be sent to the following email address: adshouston1@gmail.com. Phone conversations are not considered official communication unless the content of the correspondence is documented by follow-up email.
- 3. You will be notified by the Scholarship Committee via email regarding the following:
 - a. Confirmation of receipt of your application.
 - b. Confirmation of your eligibility to apply to the scholarship program.
 - **c.** The results presented by the Selection Committee and decision by the Houston ADS Board.

How the Selection Process Works

- 1. Applicants that meet <u>ALL</u> the eligibility requirements are evaluated by a Selection Committee.
- 2. Supporting documents are crucial in the selection process and help score and rank the candidates. The Selection Committee scores each applicant taking into account the following factors and recommends applicants for a scholarship based on their overall score:

3. If you are selected for a scholarship award:

- a. You will be granted a conditional approval for a scholarship award. The scholarship is conditional upon your submittal of the spring 2022 semester transcripts that confirm you are in good academic standing based on the semester grades.
- **b.** You will be allowed up to two weeks following notification of your conditional approval to submit your transcripts for the spring 2022 semester.
- **c.** Upon verification of Item b by the Selection Committee, your conditional approval will be changed to "Approved".
- d. The scholarship will be paid by the ADS Chapter directly to the academic institution you will be attending.
