Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA)

Anyone interested in becoming a Catholic becomes part of this process, as any Catholic who has not received all the sacraments of initiation, Baptism, Confirmation, Eucharist and Reconciliation. For Further information please contact the Parish Office at 570-296-7451

Baptism

Baptism is usually celebrated on the last Sunday of the month during the 11:00 am Sunday Mass. Expectant and new parents are asked to participate in a Baptismal Preparation class for their first child in the Parish. Call the parish office to make an appointment.

Marriage

Congratulations! Couples contemplating marriage are asked to contact the Parish Office at least six months before their marriage so that the appropriate preparations can be made for this special celebration.

Confirmation

Confirmation is ordinarily celebrated by the Bishop every two years. Candidates must complete a two year preparation program and be at least 12 years old or in the sixth grade.

Communion to the Homebound

Communion to the home-bound is brought weekly by lay Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Contact the Parish Office to make arrangements.

Ministry to the Sick

The Anointing of the Sick is for the comfort and strength of those who are ill. When there is a need please call the Parish Office. If someone is homebound please notify the office so arrangements can be made for the reception of Holy Communion.
