



## Havre de Grace Maritime Museum Sets up Boat at JoRetro

In keeping with a summer theme and boating on the Upper Chesapeake Bay, the Havre de Grace Maritime Museum is collaborating with JoRetro to provide a summertime maritime ambiance to the front window at their store located at 137 North Washington Street in Havre de Grace.



This boat, the Chessy, is a 16-foot wooden hull fishing and crabbing boat. The boat was built by the talented men of the Maritime Museum's Boat Shop in 2016. It is made of oak, poplar and pine and is based on vintage 1948 drawings in *Mechanics Illustrated*. The boat is equipped with a rebuilt vintage 1948 Johnson Sea Horse 5 horsepower outboard engine.
