## **DC UPDATE**

That same bipartisan support will mean we have a stronger starting point when the ETNA and its domestically focused companion, the <u>Comprehensive TB Elimination Act</u>, are re-introduced in 2023. In the meantime, Appropriations (AKA show me the money!) season will begin as soon as the new Congress is sworn in. Stay tuned for reasons to get in touch with your members of Congress—the ultimate arbiters of the people's purse strings!

# **TB Elimination Alliance Announces New Mini-Grant Recipients**

The <u>TB Elimination Alliance (TEA)</u> recently <u>announced</u> 14 mini-grant awards to community partners working to increase awareness and build capacity for latent TB infection testing and treatment. TEA is led by the <u>Association of Asian Pacific Community Health Organizations (AAPCHO)</u>, <u>Asian & Pacific Islander American Health Forum (APIAHF)</u>, <u>Hepatitis B Foundation (HBF)</u>, and <u>Stop TB USA</u>, with the support of CDC.
