DESCRIPTION: This is one of the early Pearson Mustang 975 all-purpose bows. White face limbs, black back limbs. Attractive rosewood overlays on the face of the limbs in the riser area. This bow has been reconditioned. Bow has no delamination; no cracks; limbs are straight. Overlays and tips are in great condition. No chips, dings or cracks. No stress lines or crazing. A few minor scratches and nicks here and there. The only flaw with this bow is that a former owner inserted a bushing on the side of the riser, and there were scratches around the bushing where a quiver was likely attached. The bushing was removed and filled with wood epoxy; you can see where the general area was re-stained. This is only visible from close up (see pic on last page). The Decal is in good condition. Overall, this is a really nice bow in excellent condition for its age. The early Mustang was priced just above the Pinto, and several steps above the Stallion and Javelina models.
