CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

The latest update on the thrift store storage building construction project on the back lot at Saint Paul.

The soil analysis has arrived and it recommends a maximum of seven feet of excavation and five-foot margins. The upper two feet of topsoil are spoiled with roots, vegetation and other organic matter. Therefore, it needs to be completely removed, disposed of and replaced.

Our contractor has recommended the removal of two feet of top soil, excavating another two feet and scaring an additional one foot, including five-foot margins. Refilling and compacting for a total of five feet. We are waiting for Father Dave's response to these recommendations, after which we can dig and pour the cement slab and continue with the construction.

We want to thank John and Patty Simmerman for the approved proposal of this building as well as Lynn Olds, our heaven-sent contractor and a couple other folks who have contributed their time and energy to see this project through.
