Games in Rotation Order

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Thursday, September 29th

BYU 42 Utah St 17. BYU has disappointed us the last couple of weeks but Utah St has been the much bigger disappointment at 0-4 ATS failing to cover by 17 ppg. BYU can name the score but note they have Notre Dame on deck.

Friday, September 30th

HOUSTON 30 Tulane 27. Houston continues to struggle this year especially on defense allowing 443 ypg. We bet Tulane and the UNDER on the openers but can no longer recommend either at the current numbers.

2★ Utsa 35 MIDDLE TENNESSEE 28. Normally, we'd like the home team on a short week but this spot favors UTSA. The Roadrunners are off a blowout win over an FCS team while MT is off arguably their biggest win in school history. There have been 5 teams this season that have pulled off outright upsets as 18-point or more underdogs. The next week those teams are 0-5 ATS failing to cover by 14.3 ppg! Maybe MT is due for a letdown here.

BOISE ST 24 San Diego St 17. After last week's shocking upset loss to UTEP, Boise fired their offensive coordinator and their starting QB hit the transfer portal. Time to fade them right? Wrong! We thought the market over-reacted and a sharp betting syndicate took Boise -4 on Monday morning.

Washington 34 UCLA 30. UCLA's strength of schedule ranks a putrid No. 162 in the Sagarin ratings. Meanwhile, Washington is much improved at 4-0 SU and 4-0 ATS. Huskies are the more proven commodity and remember HC DeBoer brought Fresno to the Rose Bowl last year and got a win. DeBoer coached teams are 71% ATS since 2016.

Unlv 30 NEW MEXICO 17. UNLV is 4-0 ATS this season covering by an average of 12.5 ppg. However, they had a misleading win last week vs Utah St where they were +6 in TO's. We bet New Mexico +17 on the openers.

Saturday, October 1st

Wisconsin 25 ILLINOIS 16. A lot of early week money has come in on Illinois. The Illini defense is legit allowing just 8 ppg (No. 4) and 235 ypg (No. 5). We expect Wisconsin to bounce back from the blowout loss to Ohio St but prefer the UNDER.

PENN ST 38 Northwestern 13. Northwestern has lost 3 consecutive games outright as a TD-plus favorite. However, they are back in their preferred dog role. **Louisville 31 BOSTON COLLEGE 20.** BC is 0-4 ATS failing to cover by 11.6 ppg. The Eagles' OL is among the worst in the country as they can't run (60 rush ypg, No. 128) and can't protect the QB allowing 15 sacks (No. 126). Still, we think there's value on them here with an inflated spread.

COASTAL CAROLINA 36 Georgia Southern 26. Note that both QB's were banged up last week but should play here. The weather could also be bad. There's been support for the dog and UNDER (we bet both) but don't see much value now.

FLORIDA ST 36 Wake Forest 30. We've seen this point-spread go back and forth from -6.5 to -7. We think the Noles are the "sharper" side but you're certainly not getting them at a discount vs a Wake team that impressed us last week.

ARMY 33 Georgia St 24. Georgia St has really disappointed this season at 0-4 SU and 0-3-1 ATS. Army comes in off the bye. We like Army.

CLEMSON 26 NC State 18. The current total of 40 says the weather will be really bad here. We unfortunately bet OVER on the Sunday openers. Both teams are 4-0 SU but neither has been over-whelming compared to expectations. We were really disappointed with Clemson on these pages last week (only loser the entire weekend!). We think Clemson is the right side.

PITTSBURGH 38 Georgia Tech 16. Georgia Tech fired head coach Geoff Collins. Brent Key will serve as the interim here. A case could be made that GT played by far their best game of the season last week out-gaining UCF 452-333. We like OVER.

MARYLAND 31 Michigan St 26. Michigan St is really banged up especially on defense and were run over by Minnesota last week. Maryland did impress at Michigan. Still, our numbers say value on Michigan St here.

2★ Virginia 26 DUKE 24. Virginia has been a big disappointment this year but their defense is allowing just 19 ppg. Duke is playing well but enough to be laying more than a FG in a conference game? We like Virginia outright as it's one of our strongest power ratings plays. Make sure you're checking the weather.

NORTH CAROLINA 31 Virginia Tech 23. What a pathetic performance defensively last week from North Carolina. Off a bye, the Tar Heels allowed a questionable ND offense go up and down the field on them. They take on another feeble unit here. Will the weather slow down NC's pass offense?

3★ Liberty 24 OLD DOMINION 20. We like Liberty here. We think they get back QB Kaidon Salter after he missed last week's game. The Flames are being punished too much for the performance vs Akron last week. Liberty was down a half-dozen starters and were playing with a 3rd-string QB. Liberty has wins over Southern Miss, UAB and should have upset Wake Forest. Meanwhile, ODU despite a 2-2 record is -148 ypg on the season.

Northern Illinois 33 BALL ST 29. Will Rocky Lombardi return here for NIU? The Huskies nearly upset Kentucky without him last week. Ball St is a team we want to fade all season. Lean NIU.

MINNESOTA 32 Purdue 19. Minnesota is 4-0 ATS covering their games by an average of 12.75 ppg. The Gophers are +40 ppg and +355 ypg on the season. That's not good news for Purdue team that struggled without QB O'Connell last week (check status). We bet Minnesota -9 on the openers.

JAMES MADISON 36 Texas St 16. James Madison is 3-0 ATS covering by 19 ppg. Last week they won outright at App St. However, this week we think you're finally paying a premium if you want to back them.

AIR FORCE 27 Navy 13. Since 2001, UNDERS are 49-11-3 in Service Academy games between Air Force, Army and Navy including a 21-2-1 run. The total opened a very low 34.5 and was actually bet up. We aren't involved.

BAYLOR 29 Oklahoma St 27. Every game in the Big 12 this year could have title implications. Do we really know how good Oklahoma St is in 2022? Their strength of schedule ranks No. 143 in Sagarin's ratings.

3★ Iowa St 32 KANSAS 26. Kansas is 4-0 ATS this season covering by 17.5 ppg. How can we go against them? Easy, we think you're paying a big premium wanting to back them this week and it started to creep into the market last week (they only covered by 1 vs Duke). Iowa St is the best team they've played so far. The Cyclones have the much better defense allowing 15 ppg and 266 ypg vs 27 ppg and 400 ypg while playing the tougher schedule.

South Alabama 30 UL-LAFAYETTE 21. The Jags are 4-0 ATS covering by 18.25 ppg. They're taking on a ULL team that played a pair of bottom-tier teams in Rice and ULM the last two weeks. The Cajuns lost both outright and were worse in the box score in both. South Alabama was our top VIP play earlier this week when we gave them out at -5.5. However, we can't recommend them at -9.

MEMPHIS 37 Temple 17. Don't look now but Temple has covered 3 straight games and their defense has allowed just 15 ppg so far this season. They'll get their toughest test here. We don't see much value.

Cincinnati 34 TULSA 26. We like Tulsa here. Cincy was severely outplayed in the second half vs an overrated Indiana team last week. Meanwhile, Tulsa out-scored Ole Miss 10-0 in the second half even without QB Davis Brin. Brin was called "day-to-day" and wanted to come back in the game last week. However, practice reports weren't as positive on Tuesday. Note Tulsa is 3-0 ATS vs Cincy the last 3 years with two near outright upsets.

EASTERN MICHIGAN 37 Massachusetts 17. UMass got shutout vs Temple last week as their offense continues to struggle averaging just 10 ppg and 248 ypg. EMU looked flat off the upset of Arizona St and lost outright to Buffalo. We're passing here.

UTAH 33 Oregon St 23. Oregon St covered vs USC last week despite being -4 in TO's. Utah has rebounded since the Florida loss to cover 3 straight. We feel both of these teams are "play-on" in Pac-12 play.

NEW MEXICO ST 33 Florida International 20. How bad is FIU? After last week's 73-0 loss to WKU, they find themselves 2-TD underdogs to a fellow bottom 6 team. The Aggies are a 2-TD favorite for only the 3rd time in 19 years! With that being said, we would lean FIU at anything above 14.

WASHINGTON ST 28 California 24. How about Cal true frosh RB Jayden Ott running for 274 yards last week. Meanwhile, Wazzu got the wild cover vs Oregon in a game they were out-gained by 196 yards. We think Cal is the sharper side here but we haven't gotten to the window.

ARIZONA 35 Colorado 20. How bad is Colorado? The Buffs are 0-4 ATS failing to cover by 11.25 ppg and we think they are by far the worst Power 5 team. If this line holds it will be the largest Pac-12 favorite role for Arizona since 2012.

USC 41 Arizona St 18. There's going to come a time later this season where USC isn't +4 in TO's in a game. Right now, the Trojans are by far No. 1 in turnover margin at +14 and we think they are overrated in the AP poll at No. 6. We think you're paying a premium here but it is tough backing an ASU team with an interim coach.

OREGON 38 Stanford 23. Oregon has rebounded nicely since the opening blowout loss to Georgia. They have revenge here for getting upset last year while Stanford continues to tumble under David Shaw.

OLE MISS 30 Kentucky 25. We're a little surprised to see so much love for Ole Miss this week. The Rebels haven't played anyone in our Top 75 yet. Kentucky already has one road upset this year and we think they cover here.

KANSAS ST 32 Texas Tech 25. Both teams are coming off big outright upsets over heavyweights Oklahoma and Texas. Who keeps the momentum going here in the wide open Big 12? We think Kansas St is the sharper side as Texas Tech's post-game win expectancy was only 2.4% last week. Pass.

OHIO ST 49 Rutgers 10. The Buckeyes' offense the last two weeks is the team we expected to see when we considered them the clear 2nd best team in the country. QB CJ Stroud has a 16-to-1 TD-to-INT ratio and the defense is allowing just 16 ppg and 283 ypg. They can name the score here.

MISSISSIPPI ST 25 Texas A&M 22. A lot of respected money has come in on Mississippi St in this game as they are +113 ypg on the season. Meanwhile, A&M was -129 yards vs App St, -128 yards vs Miami and -72 yards last week in a fortunate win vs Arkansas. They lost by far their top WR in Ainius Smith for the season. We did see some buy back on A&M Wednesday morning.

Oklahoma 36 TCU 30. The market expects Oklahoma to rebound after the upset loss to Kansas St last week. We agree and laid -4.5 on Sunday. Do note that TCU is 3-0 ATS under new head coach Sonny Dykes.

Michigan 27 IOWA 17. Michigan played their first team that isn't among the worst in the country last week. It wasn't a great look as they struggled to beat Maryland as 17-point favorites. Iowa is 3-1 and allowing just 6 ppg (No. 1) and yet they are -4 ypg on the season!

TEXAS 35 West Virginia 26. Texas is BACK! That is right back to being overrated after an upset loss to Texas Tech last week. With no lay-ups in the Big 12, this looks like an 8-4 type of team. Will that be good enough to keep the locals happy? West Virginia is better than their 2-2 record indicates. The Mountaineers are +185 ypg.

Lsu 28 AUBURN 19. Auburn is 0-4 ATS this season failing to cover by 12.75 ppg. They had a 9% post-game win expectancy last week but were +2 in TO's as Missouri blew several chances to upset them. Meanwhile, LSU is looking good at +25 ppg and +229 ypg under Kelly. We bet LSU -6 on the open but can't recommend it now.

Alabama 37 ARKANSAS 21. No surprise the Crimson Tide are taking money in this one. However, they have struggled on the road the last 2 years and Arkansas hung in with them last year only losing by 7. Lean Arkansas.

Georgia 41 MISSOURI 14. You would have to think Georgia will respond after a lack-luster effort vs Kent St last week. Only Alabama had scored more than 17 points vs Georgia's defense the last two years. Meanwhile, how does Missouri respond after the blown game vs Auburn last week?

TOLEDO 32 Central Michigan 25. Keep an eye on Central Michigan QB Daniel Richardson who is questionable here. We bet Toledo -6.5 on the openers just in case Richardson was out. Plus, Toledo was +94 yards in a loss to San Diego St last week. Pass.

BUFFALO 27 Miami, Oh 26. Big game in the MAC East Division. Both teams come in off upsets with Miami taking down Northwestern and Buffalo notching their first win of 2022 over EMU. Early week money is on Buffalo.

Fresno St 38 CONNECTICUT 15. Fresno comes in off a bye but it looks like QB Jake Haener won't play here. Connecticut needs a bye as they are the most banged up team in the country at the offensive skill positions.

BOWLING GREEN 33 Akron 23. We like Bowling Green here. They should get back both QB Matt McDonald (10-0 ratio) and HC Scot Loeffler after both missed last week's game at Mississippi St. Meanwhile, Akron benefited from playing a Liberty team without several starters and on a 3rd-string QB last week.

KENT ST 38 Ohio 28. Kent St has taken a ton of money in this game. We are a part of it as we bet Kent St -7. The Golden Flashes have played the toughest schedule in the country so far (At Washington, Oklahoma and Georgia). Meanwhile, Ohio almost lost to FCS Fordham last week.

ARKANSAS ST 32 UL-Monroe 25. We bet ULM +10 on the openers. Terry Bowden is doing a good job there as they pulled the outright upset over rival ULL. Meanwhile, Arkansas St is quietly 4-0 ATS covering by an average of 12 ppg. Don't see much value now.

Florida Atlantic 33 NORTH TEXAS 31. We think North Texas at +3.5 is worth a bet. They out-gained Memphis by 139 yards last week but were -2 in TO's. This is being hailed as head coach Seth Littrell's last stand if he wants to regain momentum from early on in his tenure.

Utep 27 CHARLOTTE 24. This total has dropped 10 points so keep an eye towards the weather forecast. UTEP is coming off the big upset over Boise St. How will they handle it? Do note the UNDER is 4-0-1 in their games this season but Charlotte games have averaged 71 total ppg. We can't recommend anything at the current numbers.

NEBRASKA 32 Indiana 26. Nebraska is off a bye and just playing the season out with an interim coach. The Huskers are 0-4 ATS this year failing to cover by 18.4 ppg. Yet, here we were betting them -2.5 on the Sunday openers. Generally speaking, we think Indiana is overrated as they were fortunate in wins over Illinois and WKU.

WESTERN KENTUCKY 32 Troy 26. WKU is off the 73-0 beat down of FIU covering by 6 TD's but we were actually more impressed with Troy last week as they upset Marshall limiting the Thundering Herd to just 174 total yards. We made 63 bets on Sunday morning, this game wasn't one of them.

Uab 31 RICE 22. UAB comes in off a bye. Meanwhile, Rice has covered 3 straight games and look like a much improved team this year. After pulling an outright upset vs ULL as a double-digit do and nearly doing the same last week, we would lean with them "+10".

San Jose St 24 WYOMING 22. A lot of money has come in on San Jose St in this game and we are a part of it as took San Jose +2 on Sunday. That's the second week in a row, they have seen their point spread move 5 points or more. Wyoming has impressed so far this season but note they are -84 ypg.

† **East Carolina 33 South Florida 24.** @FAU Stadium in Boca Raton, FL. This game has been moved due to Hurricane Ian. To show you how insignificant USF's home-field advantage is, ECU was -9 at USF and are now -9.5. What is USF's mind-set after losing a close game to Florida and then getting crushed last week on top of worries about friends and families with the storm. We trust ECU to bounce back after the loss to Navy last week.

Sunday, October 2nd

UCF 34 Smu 29. This game has been moved due to Hurricane Ian. Will UCF's practice schedule be disrupted this week? We thought they were the right side here when we bet them on Sunday. The Mustangs have held up well in back-to-back losses to Maryland and TCU the last couple of weeks.

Week 5 Computer Projected Lines for Every CFB Game

For the past six seasons we have posted computer projected lines for every game on Wednesday. **Games where there was of difference of more than 3 points saw our computer lines actually beat the Vegas line at a 421-355-12 (54%) clip! So far this season those games are 13-14.** That's pretty solid and actually better than our own handicapping in some seasons. Keep in mind, these computer lines don't take into consideration off-the-field factors like revenge or flat spots or if there are late-week injuries. They are basically a power-rating number difference between the two teams that also takes into consideration the home field advantage.

Of the 6 games where our computer is off more than 3 points compared to the Vegas line (highlighted), our favorite team this week to back would be **Iowa St -3.**

The Comp column is the computer projected line and the Diff column is the difference between the Vegas line and the Computer line. "+" numbers in the difference column say back the underdog. "-" numbers in the difference column say back the favorite. Let us know if you have questions.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

CINCINNATI 26 Miami 21. Miami upset Buffalo last week despite getting out-gained 497-212. Buffalo ran 90 plays, Miami just 39. Now the 3-0 Dolphins travel on a short week to face a Cincy team that just got their first win of the season. Seems like a good spot for Cincy against a potentially tired Miami defense. However, it's priced into the market and then some. The look-ahead line had Cincy by only -1.5.

Sunday, October 2nd

† **Minnesota 23 New Orleans 21.** @Tottenham Hotspur Stadium in London, England. First London game of the season features two playoff hopefuls. New Orleans can ill afford to fall to 1-3. Last week NO had a 6.7-5.0 ypp edge as Carolina scored a on a fumble return TD and blocked a FG. Meanwhile, Minnesota rallied from a 24-10 deficit to score the game's final 18 points vs Detroit. We want to bet New Orleans here but early week money is on Minnesota which means Saints' QB Winston remains less than 100%.

INDIANAPOLIS 23 Tennessee 20. Last week we won on these pages with Indy but note that KC had a 5.2-3.8 ypp edge. KC had 4 drives inside Indy's 40-yard line result in 3 total points while Indy got a 4-yard TD "drive" after a muffed punt. Meanwhile, TEN controlled LV more than the final indicated. Early money has been on Indy but we'd lean TEN at +3.5.

N.Y. GIANTS 21 Chicago 17. A pair of 2-1 teams that are fade material in future weeks. The Bears run game got going last week with 281 yards (most since 1984) but their pass game remains bad as Justin Fields has attempted just 45 total passes! The Giants are off a short week after losing to Dallas on MNF but this is their 3rd straight home game and we think they have the better first-year head coach.

Buffalo 29 BALTIMORE 25. We've seen some early week money on the UNDER with possible remnants of Hurricane Ian. Last week, the Bills dominated the Dolphins with 497-212 yard and 90-39 play edges but somehow lost. Meanwhile, Baltimore got a road win in New England as they were 5 for 5 in the red zone while New England was 3 for 5 in the RZ and the Pats were -2 in TO's. The Baltimore defense was beat badly again. Provided the weather isn't too bad, we lean Buffalo and OVER.

L.A. Chargers 24 HOUSTON 20. The Chargers come in off the blowout loss to Jacksonville with Justin Herbert looking far less than 100%. It wasn't just Herbert, the Chargers had injury issues at WR, Center, DB and the DL. Houston has exceeded expectations so far and provided the Chargers injury issues remain, we'd lean with the home dog.

DETROIT 27 Seattle 23. All Detroit does is cover point-spreads under head coach Dan Campbell as they are 3-0 ATS this year and on a 10-2 ATS run dating back to last season. However, this is now a steep favorite role for them. They've only won twice in their last 31 games by more than a TD. We lean dog and OVER.

PITTSBURGH 22 N.Y. Jets 17. The Steelers need a win sitting at 1-2 off back-to-back losses. The Jets have gotten a ton of yards and points in garbage time in each of their 3 games and even got the miraculous comeback vs Cleveland. We think Pittsburgh is the right side with extra time to rest off the Thursday loss to Cleveland.

PHILADELPHIA 28 Jacksonville 20. Philadelphia has been the most impressive NFC team through 3 weeks of the season. Last week the Eagles had a 5.9-3.2 ypp edge and it could have been worse than the 24-8 final vs Washington. Every single week the Eagles take money in the market place. Meanwhile, Jacksonville is off to a surprising 2-1 start off back-to-back wins over play-off hopefuls in Indianapolis and the L.A. Chargers. We lean with Philly here.

DALLAS 23 Washington 18. Kudos to the Cowboys for over-coming all the injuries to get to a 2-1 start. Their defense led by Micah Parsons has led the way. Now they get a Washington team that is among the absolute worse in the NFL and were beat far worse than the 24-8 final last week. Washington has allowed 14 sacks the last two weeks and now face a Dallas pass rush that has 11 sacks the last two weeks. Bad matchup for Washington and Dallas has covered 7 straight in division.

Cleveland 26 ATLANTA 24. Cleveland has extra rest for this one after beating Pittsburgh on Thursday Night. The Falcons are 3-0 ATS this season and have played in 3 straight close games while coming off a long road trip (stayed out West last week). We wonder what this line would be had Cleveland held on in the Jets game?

CAROLINA 23 Arizona 21. A lot of early week money is on Carolina in this one. The Panthers were -1.7 in ypp last week in their win over New Orleans which has us pausing at this time. However, the Cardinals were -2.9 in ypp vs the Rams. Arizona is very fortunate not to be 0-3 on the season and outside the second half vs Las Vegas have been dominated the other 10 quarters. They are dead last in ypp differential (-1.9) this season.

2★ LAS VEGAS 25 Denver 20. At 0-3 the Raiders season is basically on the line here. There was a lengthy closed-door meeting with Josh McDaniels and Mark Davis after last week's 2-point loss to the Titans. However, we don't think it's as bad as it seems (it never is in the parity-driven NFL). Las Vegas lost 3 close games to playoff teams from last season but note those teams are 0-6 in their other games this year. They're taking on an overrated Denver team that while we cashed with them last week, Russell Wilson doesn't look right and Nathaniel Hackett could also be in over his head.

2★ NE (plus the points) Green Bay 24 New England 17. Obviously, we've seen a lot of money on Green Bay and the UNDER with NE QB Mac Jones out. Brian Hoyer will get the start for a NE team that is +0.6 in ypp (No. 6) despite their 0-2-1 ATS record. We cashed on these pages with the Packers last week as they held on vs Tampa Bay. GB won the box score more than the final indicated. We could see a unique Patriots offense (remember the MNF game in Buffalo last season?). We'll gladly Belichick with the huge point-spread.

Kansas City 23 TAMPA BAY 21. Tampa continues to be banged up while playing high-profile games. We cashed against them last week as they lost to Green Bay which was worse than the 14-12 final indicated. Now the Bucs welcome in a KC team that should be plenty angry after losing outright in Indy. Special teams failures got the best of the Chiefs in that game. Will the Bucs' practice schedules and home life be disrupted by Hurricane Ian this week? That makes us think KC is the right side.

3★ SAN FRANCISCO 24 L.A. Rams 19. Despite their 1-2 record, the 49ers are No. 4 in the NFL in ypp margin at +1.15. SF was +1.4 in ypp last week but lost in Denver thanks to a -3 TO deficit and a dumb safety by QB Jimmy G. Note 49ers LT Trent Williams will be out but the 49ers are on a 6-1 SU and ATS run vs the Rams and their season is on the line here.
