-Clemson beat North Carolina 39-10. However, the Tigers were out-gained 386-385. Clemson was +3 in TO's including a 98-yard "Pick Six".
-Purdue had a 456-386 yard edge vs Michigan but settled for 5 FG's.

Bad Beats

-Purdue (+15) was covering the spread for 58 minutes and 38 seconds. Instead of taking a knee, Michigan punched in a TD with 1:22 left to win by 21.
-USC Caleb Williams OVER/UNDER rush yards was 32. He had 73 rushing yards in the second quarter but Utah got 7 sacks on the night and Williams would only finish with 21 yards rushing after injuring his hamstring.

Army has won 4 of the last 6 meetings but prior to those, Navy had claimed a series record 14 straight wins in one of the greatest rivalries and traditions in all of college football. Navy has been favored in 17 of the last 20 meetings and the early money has been on the Midshipmen here as they opened 1.5-point underdogs and are now 1.5-point favorites. For the third straight year, Navy started the season very slow including an upset loss to FCS Delaware in the opener. However, since the 0-2 SU/ATS start, Navy is 7-2 ATS and they have pulled 3 outright upsets highlighted by a win over UCF in their last game as 15-point underdogs. On the other side, Army is also playing their best ball of the season with 5 straight covers. Unfortunately, the NCAA didn't grant them a bowl waiver as even with a win here, a 6-6 Army team won't be heading to a bowl game because two of their wins are against FCS opponents. Speaking of schedules, Navy has played the much tougher schedule (No. 61 vs No. 126 in Sagarin) and might be a big reason the early money is on them. Totals' players note that the UNDER has cashed in 16 straight Army/Navy games by an average of 14 points per game. However, the market in our opinion has finally caught up to this UNDER trend as this year's total of 32.5 is the lowest total in the series in the last 20 years. It's also well UNDER the two teams' scoring averages for the season (Army games average 52 total ppg, Navy games average 47 total ppg). We actually lean OVER as nine of the of the last 16 meetings would have went OVER this 32.5 total.

HOME TEAM IN CAPS

Thursday, December 8th

Las Vegas 24 L.A. RAMS 18. The Raiders have turned their season around with 3 straight wins. The same can't be said for the Rams who limp in with 6 straight losses (1-4-1 ATS). Nine of the Raiders 12 games so far this season have been decided by 7 points or less so it's tough seeing them get a lot of margin here. One thing to keep an eye on is that there will be more Raiders fans than Rams fans in the stadium so do not give L.A. full home-field advantage.

Sunday, December 11th

DETROIT 26 Minnesota 25. Minnesota is 10-2 on the season but are an incredible 9-0 in one-possession games. The Vikings are -0.8 in yards per play margin ranking No. 27 in the NFL. The Lions are -0.4 in ypp and have played the tougher schedule. That's why Detroit is favored here. Detroit has won 4 of their last 5 games and has covered all 5 of them. The market is all over Minnesota being an overrated team. We're guessing 10-15 years ago, this line might be around pick. We could only bet Minnesota in a teaser.

BUFFALO 27 N.Y. Jets 17. Buffalo has revenge for losing outright as 10.5-point favorites at the Jets on November 6th. The Bills have extra time to prep after beating the Patriots 24-10 last Thursday. Meanwhile, the Jets settled for 5 FG's in the loss to the Vikings. We think the Bills get revenge but respect the Jets who are +0.5 in ypp despite facing a Top 5 toughest schedule.

PITTSBURGH 19 Baltimore 17. Don't look now but the Steelers have turned their season around with a 3-1 SU/ATS mark in their last 4 games as they try to avoid the first losing season under head coach Mike Tomlin. They get a Baltimore team that's failed to cover in 3 straight games. The Ravens will be starting Tyler Huntley at QB with Lamar Jackson out several weeks. While Pittsburgh is -0.9 in ypp margin, the Steelers have played the toughest schedule in the NFL. This is usually a very close series and we could only look to tease Baltimore with a low total.

Philadelphia 25 N.Y. GIANTS 19. The Eagles are 11-1 SU and now rank No. 1 in the NFL in ypp margin. They are coming off their best performance of the season as they destroyed Tennessee much to our dismay on these pages. However, they have played a weak schedule. The Giants are off the tie against Washington. We've been saying that the Giants are overrated all season despite the 7-4-1 record. Give them credit as the market also doesn't respect them and yet the G-Men are 9-3 ATS.

2★ CINCINNATI 27 Cleveland 19. Is there anyone in the NFL playing better than the Bengals right now? Cincy is 9-1 ATS in their last 10 games and QB Joe Burrow just moved to 3-0 vs Patrick Mahomes and the Chiefs the last two years with last week's upset win. Now they face a Cleveland team that had a very misleading win over Houston last week as the Browns scored 3 non-offensive TD's in Deshaun Watson's return. Watson looked very rusty last week and we don't think he can keep pace with Burrow here. Cincy has revenge for the MNF loss to Cleveland earlier this season.

1★ TENNESSEE 23 Jacksonville 17. Tennessee comes in off their worst performance since Week 2 as they got crushed at Philly last week. The GM was fired this week and we think that's a good thing as it was a vote of confidence for head coach Vrabel. The Jags are also off a terrible performance in the blowout loss to the Lions. It shouldn't come as a surprise for this franchise. The players and coaches change and the results stay the same. Jacksonville is 2-7 ATS in their last 9 games (Tennessee is 7-2 ATS their last 9). We expect Tennessee to bounce back.

DALLAS 31 Houston 16. This is the largest point spread in the NFL this season. Since 2015, 14-point or more favorites in the NFL are 40-21-4 ATS (65.6%). The Cowboys offense has really picked up with Dak back in the lineup as they have 39.8 ppg the last 5 weeks. Combine that with a defense that ranks No. 1 in DVOA and the Cowboys are pretty scary. Meanwhile, the Texans are scary bad at 1-10-1 SU and are 1-6 ATS in their last 7. They had a misleading loss to Cleveland last week but we're not running to the window here to bet them.

Miami 27 L.A. CHARGERS 26. Miami has a lot of weapons and a young head coach that everyone seems to love. However, we think they've been over-valued in the market and the Dolphins are just 2-6-1 ATS in their last 9 games. Even though they faced a backup QB for most of last week's game vs SF, they still were out-classed. Miami does have the big stats edge with a +0.9 ypp margin (No. 5) vs the Chargers -0.9 ypp (No. 30). That's why they're laying points on the road. We lean L.A.

SEATTLE 25 Carolina 20. Carolina has played much better under interim coach Steve Wilks. The Panthers are 5-1 ATS in their last 6 games and are a respectable -0.1 in ypp margin despite a 4-8 record. The Seahawks have not been playing their best ball as of late with 3 straight non-covers. They are still firmly in the playoff race though and can ill afford a slip-up at home here.

2★ TB (plus the points) SAN FRANCISCO 18 Tampa Bay 17.

We won on these pages with San Francisco last week but the 49ers lost QB Jimmy G for an extended period (probably the season) to a foot injury. Brock Purdy did well in his absence but now the Bucs have tape on him. We think San Francisco's DL will have their way vs Tampa's OL but Tampa might have saved their season with that MNF comeback win. In a low-scoring game, we will take the "hook" with the Bucs with the GOAT QB Brady vs a rookie QB.

Kansas City 24 DENVER 17. Totals' players note that the UNDER is 11-1 in Denver games this season. While the Broncos season has been a dumpster fire at 3-9 SU and 4-8 ATS, they are 12-1 to this 9.5-point spread as they've lost only one game by more than 9 points. KC should be motivated after losing at Cincinnati last week but it's tough getting margin on a Denver defense that ranks No. 2 in the NFL in yards per play allowed.

Monday, December 12th

New England 23 ARIZONA 21. The Patriots have extra time to prep after losing to the Bills on Thursday night. The Cardinals also have extra prep after a bye. The Cardinals are just No. 30 in DVOA while NE ranks No. 9 in ypp margin and No. 12 in DVOA. That's why they are the road favorites here. It's also Belichick off a loss vs Kingsbury who couldn't even cut it in the Big 12.
