- 2. Case management and counseling help individuals with chronic illnesses and disabilities to access needed social and medical services.

3. Durable medical equipment & disposable medical supplies help people with disabilities to maintain their daily activities.

offers the following services:

- 1. Durable Medical Equipment for Children: AWO provides wheelchairs, strollers, corner chairs, gait trainers, and other home health equipment.
- 2. Durable Medical Equipment for Adults: AWO provides wheelchairs, walkers, crutches, commodes, bathroom aids, canes, and other home health equipment.
- 3. *Disposable Medical Supplies:* AWO gives away many disposable items such as adult diapers and catheters.
- 4. *Life Care: AWO* provides case management services for the chronic ill and disabled.
- **5.** *Home Secure:* **AWO** installs grab bars, hand-held shower hoses, non-skid surfaces, locks, lockboxes & smoke detectors.

6. Life Coaching: AWO


provides counseling to consumers with developmental or physical disabilities and their families for the purpose of assisting in the alleviation of problems of adjustment and interpersonal relationships.

Durable medical equipment otherwise known as (dme) is equipment that:

- 1. can be used over and over again;
- 2. is ordinarily used for medical purposes; and,
- 3. is generally not useful to a person who is not sick, injured or disabled.



Many people with healthcare related problems that live at home often need the use of dme that assists them in meeting their daily activities and hygiene needs.
