## **A MESSAGE FROM WALK #120 LAY DIRECTOR**

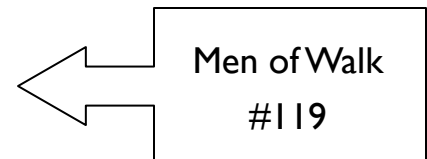

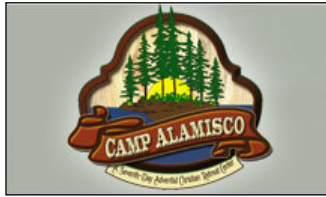
