Ground Improvements



We have been realising the benefits of the programme of work we undertook at Knock Field last summer to improve our playing areas, to provide power, water and drainage at the site and to improve access and parking. We have further minor works to undertake at the end of this season to deal with a drainage issue around the access to the seating area overlooking Pitch 1. We will also be providing further fencing and a spectator viewing platform, suitable for wheelchair access and for push chairs/buggies, to overlook both the Junior Pitch and Pitch 1. Subject to funding, we wish to further extend our parking area at the top of the site to avoid the need for cars to park on the road outside of the site.

Please note that toilet facilities are now available to both players and spectators in the portakabin at Knock Field.

Parking for Pitches 2 and 3



We are very pleased that the new car parking area that we have provided for Pitches 2 and 3 has substantially reduced the congestion problems caused by roadside parking. We have a few outstanding tasks to complete to finish off the work that we hope to complete soon. The arrangements are now much safer for players and spectators accessing our pitches as we have a safe route from the car park to Pitch 3 and onward to Pitch 2 across a safer crossing point. Following a request through our County Councillor, David Howlett, Pembrokeshire County Council has agreed to improve the road markings and warning signs to help manage the speed of passing traffic. We ask all players and visitors to these pitches to use our car park and to travel with caution along this stretch of road.
