# Minutes of Regular Trustee Meeting Liberty Township, Licking County, Ohio November 14, 2022

## Opening

- The regular monthly meeting of the Liberty Township trustees was held on Monday, November 14, 2022 in the shop behind the township hall building. Bill Seigel, township trustee chairperson, called the meeting to order at 6:30 p.m. He led the Pledge of Allegiance and stated that the meeting is being recorded.
- Roll call was taken with the following answering as present: Bill Siegel and Bill Bogantz.
- Bill Siegel stated that the minutes for the Regular Meeting on October 10, 2022 are available in the back of the room.
- Bill Bogantz made a motion to approve the minutes from the October 10th, 2022,
   Regular Trustee meeting. Bill Siege seconded the motion. The motion passed with all
   YES votes.

# Resident/Public Input

• Linda Harger asked if the airstrip that is partially in Liberty Township needs a special permit. Ed Wasem is looking into it.

### Zoning

- Ed said that he is not working any new zoning issues.
- Ed is working with the County Prosecutor's Office to clarify enforcement of Ag Exemption permits.
- Melodie informed the trustees that the Zoning Commission is recommending, to the
  trustees, updates to the Zoning Resolution that have been approved by the Zoning
  Commission. There are two changes. The first is to clarify that only buildings 150 square
  feet or less can be built 10 feet from the side and back property lines. The second takes
  out the wording that restricts when election signs can be displayed.
- The trustees agreed to hold a Public Hearing over these two changes at their next trustee meeting on 12/12/2022.
