After a terrific Silver Anniversary event a year ago, the Ride for Sight is set to embark on its next quarter-decade with the 26th annual ride.

For the 11th consecutive year we are pleased to be teaming up with the Cheyenne Eye Clinic and Surgery Center as our title sponsor and what a great run we've had with them, seeing consistent increases in total rider's and funds generated for our vision-related programs.

Once again our event kicks off with a complimentary pre-ride pasta dinner courtesy of Piccolo Venti on Saturday evening, Aug. 4, from 6:30-7:30 p.m. at the historic Old West Museum. As usual, all of the museum attractions will be available for viewing before and after the dinner. As with tradition, the evening will feature a variety of door prizes plus a chance to buy tickets for store credit at Rock on Wheels provided by Rock on Wheels and the Cheyenne Sunrise Lions Club with 1st prize being \$1,000 of credit, 2nd prize \$650 credit and 3rd prize \$350 credit.

The Ride for Sight itself is set for Sunday, Aug. 5, getting underway with a continental breakfast at 6 a.m. at the North Cheyenne Community Park. As always, riders will have their choice of several route options of 10, 20, 30, 40 and 50 miles plus the full century or the metric routes of 50 and 100 kilometers. Needless to say, you can ride any distance you desire by just turning around at your own convenience.

Riders will find rest stops every 10 miles featuring drinks, fruit, snacks and energy foods plus toilet facilities. The event concludes with a post-ride lunch in addition to the awarding of various participation prizes. And, don't worry about racing back for lunch as it will be available until the final rider has cleared the course. Even if you are running really late, we'll package a meal for you!

The Ride for Sight is fully supported with sag wagons, roving mechanics and HAM radio assistance. Nobody gets left on the course, either, as we carefully patrol the route at the end of the day and monitor every rider. And, of course, it wouldn't be the Ride for Sight without your complimentary T-shirt, water bottle, meal tickets, discount coupons and merchandise prizes!
