

St. Josephine Bakhita – Feb 8th

St Josephine's feast day is celebrated on February 8th. St. Josephine was born in Sudan in North East Africa. When she was eight years old she was kidnapped and sold as a slave. She was so young that she couldn't remember the name her parents gave her so she was given the name "Bakhita", which means "lucky one". During her time as a slave St. Josephine was tortured, abused, and mutilated. When she was fourteen she became a nanny and during this time learned about God from the Sisters of Charity. Although the family she was with wanted to return

Josephine to Africa, she fought to stay in Italy with the Sisters of Charity. With the help of civil rights and religious authorities she was able to stay. She was baptized, confirmed, and join the Sisters of Charity. She prayed for the safety of her town (Schio) during WWI and WWII, and it was spared from damage - a feat credited to her prayer. St. Josephine Bakhita is the Patron Saint of Sudan, Africa, and against human trafficking.






