## FIREBALL JELL-O SHOTS

A crowd pleaser at any tailgate party.

## Ingredients

1 c. apple cider
1-3 oz. box orange jell-o
1 c. cold Fireball cinnamon whiskey
Bring cider to a boil and mix in jell-o. Allow to cool 15 to 20 minutes.

Stir in cold Fireball.
Pour into shot glasses, stirring constantly as you go since apple cider tends to settle.

Refrigerate until set, at least 2 hours.


## MINI CHEESE BALL APPETIZER

These individual cheese balls can be made ahead.

## Ingredients

2-8 oz. packages cream cheese, softened
4 oz. parmesan cheese, grated
4 oz . white cheddar cheese, grated
$1 / 2$ c. finely chopped pecans
$1 / 4$ c. thinly sliced chives
1/4 c. minced onions

## Coating

1/2 c. thinly sliced chives
1/2 c. finely chopped pecans
30 pretzel sticks
Combine the ingredients in a large bowl, stirring until combined.


Use a small cookie scoop, and then roll into a
ball using your hands.
Place chives and pecans into separate, shallow bowls.
Roll the cheese balls into coatings and spear with a pretzel stick.
Refrigerate until ready to serve.
If preparing more than 4 hours in advance, don't add the pretzel sticks until ready to serve.
Good with assorted crackers and pretzels.
