

Texas Scramble - Mexican Standoff - No Gimmies Allowed.

The Player whose best drive is used cannot hit a second shot, unless it is to putt on a par three.

- . Enter the names of the players on your score card.
- . The 80% rule is used, we have calculated it for you.
- . All teams must use at least 4 tee shots per player.
- . After the tee shot, play is to be continued according to regular scramble format, using the best shot, until the ball is holed out.
- . Players can move the ball one club length on the fairway, or one putter head width on the green, or 12 inches in a bunker to improve the lie, but no closer to the hole.
- . Record your gross team score on the bottom half of the score card, and turn it in to Vern at the end of the round.
- . Mark an X to indicate whose tee shot was used.

We will calculate the winning scores.

3 Man teams, play as regular 4 man teams. Players are not required to hit a second shot. No phantom rule.
2 Man teams need a third or fourth player.
