From The Board:

The Sugar Mill HOA Board has finalized the 2015 budget for operation of the association. A two percent increase in homeowner's dues for 2015 will be necessary to compensate for inflation in the costs of operating the Association. Invoices for the dues will be sent out this month. Full payment is due by January 31, 2015.

Landscape Committee Plans

The recently formed landscape committee has spent considerable time and effort reviewing the landscaping in the approximately 50 street cul de sacs maintained by the Association. The Board has accepted the recommendations of the landscape committee to begin upgrading the cul de sac landscaping with drought tolerant native plants. Work is currently underway on eight of the cul de sacs that were determined by the landscape committee to be the most in need of upgrading. The current plan is to observe how the new landscaping fares during the summer of 2015. A second set of cul de sacs will be upgraded in the fall of 2015. It is anticipated that all cul de sacs will be upgraded within 6 years.

University Blvd. Extension

The City of Sugar Land is in the final stages of designing the extension on University Blvd north of Hwy 90 to Stadium Drive. The new road will require an at-grade crossing on the railroad tracks north of Hwy 90. Union Pacific railroad requires that another track crossing is closed before the University Blvd crossing is open. The current plan is to permanently close the crossing at Wood Street (just east of Mail Street) when the northern section of University Blvd is opened in early 2016.

Marion's Fishing Corner



Trying to cope with the wind -

On a cold, blustery day, most anglers (including myself) prefer to seek calm, protected areas to

fish. But while you may be more comfortable and have fewer backlashes by avoiding the wind, your fishing success can sometimes suffer as a result. Fighting a strong wind while trying to fish has always been frustrating for me. But on some occasions, the wind can actually be used to your advantage. Here are some scenarios to consider the next time you are faced with trying to catch a few fish on a blustery day.

The wind will sometimes activate bass and other species of fish into biting by setting up a food chain event. Plankton blooms that drift on or near the surface can get blown towards the banks in certain areas of the lake. Baitfish like threadfin shad and fathead minnows move shallow to feed on the plankton, and bass, sensing a feeding opportunity, move in to gorge on the baitfish.

The wind also creates current that makes bass congregate in certain areas. Depending on the direction of the wind, some of the rounded bulkhead areas will be attractive to feeding fish. There will be some current sweeping around the edges of these bulkheads, and bass

will sometimes hold around these current edges to rush out and ambush passing baitfish. I've found this to be true on several occasions. Also, as the season progresses and the water gets colder, the wind can affect water temperatures in some areas of the lake. On sunny winter days, the top layer of water will warm a few degrees compared to the deeper water. Strong wind will blow this warmer top layer against the downwind bulkheads and create areas of water that are four or five degrees warmer than the rest of the lake. This temperature difference can be enough to congregate baitfish and predator fish that are seeking some relief from the colder temperatures.

So I am making a conscious effort to change my way of thinking about fishing on windy days. Instead of just hoping for calmer conditions sometime later, I'm going to try to use the wind to help locate some active fish. Keeping a positive attitude will at least help fight off the frustrations.....

Remember to catch and release, because a bass is too valuable of a resource to catch just once....


