FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Welcome to Immanuel Baptist Church. If you are visiting us for the first time today, we especially welcome you and our hope is that you enjoy the service. We also hope you will sense the presence of the Holy Spirit this morning. If you are looking for a church home, our prayer is that you seek His direction and guidance and for you to be sensitive to His leading, wherever that might lead you.

Tonight is an evening set aside to focus on Missions as we will be receiving two reports from some of our congregation. Please plan on being here at 6:00 PM in the Chapel.

This morning I resume my series from the Book of 1 John. It seems that every form of life has something that is a threat to it. For many it is a hungry predator, but for humans, it is obvious our enemy is sin. Our struggle is to walk our talk. You see it is fairly easy to come to church on Sunday morning, attend Sunday School and the Worship Service, and hopefully hear what God's Word says about a Christian life. It might even be that we take notes during the sermon in an effort to remember more about what the Bible is about. Hopefully we hear about the love of God, and about how Jesus is our Savior. But the issue for all is to be able to walk in a way that reflects His love, and in a way that honors our Savior.

Unfortunately, as we become believers and as we trust Christ, the evil one does not like that as his goal then is to attempt to disrupt our Christian walk. Just as we all learned to walk as a child, we all must learn to walk in our faith. We do that by reading His Word, praying and listening to Him, and then focusing on what it is He had specifically for us. One of the points I have stressed recently is that we need to have less of ourselves and more of Jesus. I believe the problem in our polarized country today is SIN. It seems to be that just in my life time, the evil one has continually chiseled away at our values, morals, and family, which has impacted us all. Let us all commit to walk the talk of Christ and avoid the corrupt desires of the sinful nature.

Please let that be your focus this week!
