Other activity:

A. **Insurance.** Clerk obtained quotes from 2 providers. As renewal date was 1 June, and no meetin could be held, Clerk decided to remain with previous provider with the same cover at a premium of £202.83 for a single year (£212.33 last year).

- B. Covid 19 response. Provided updates to Naunton newsletter and updated Naunton PC website as appropriate.
- C. Auditor's report. The auditor made some minor comment, including:
 - * Council should review investment and banking regularly. Clerk can review other providers and report to Council.
 - * Internal control policy to be reviewed (last reviewed 7/2017). Clerk can include in next agenda.
 - * Council did not review the external auditor's report. Review in future (if external auditor used)
 - * Council should adopt GDPR policies for staff, councillors and the public. Clerk can use templates and circulate for approval.
 - * Minutes to be initalled on all pages and signed on the final page.
 - * Agendas are not dated, do not have the correct summons and do not include reference to being open to the press and public Clerk's note: The Auditor viewed agendas on the website, which are for the public. Those issued to the councillors have the correct summons. However, Clerk should add date of issue on agendas.
- D. Accountability and Governance Reporting. Documents completed and internal audit carried out.
- E. Donations to Cotswold Friends note that request has been received. NPC did not donate to Cotswold Friends in 19/20 (ony grant was £102 to RDA).
- E. Website accessibility regulations. Clerk has reviewed the website in light of new accessibility regulations coming into force on September 1 2020. The only action required is to include 'Alternative text' for photographs to help visually impaired visitors to the website.
- F. TRO from Nigel Moor. Clerk has investigated costs.
