Program Description

During this program, the students will spend one semester in a design and layout lab. Their studies will include line drawing, design drawing, layout, paste-up, typesetting and photography. They will also be involved in the production lab which will include binding, silk screen printing, offset printing, press operations, block printing and plate making.

The program will also involve students in contact printing, dark-room activities, layout, design work, multiple color operations, digital photography, photo editing, web page design, and digital video.
