PRESIDENT REPORT

Here at the center, while we have not been permitted to open the pavilion for party rentals, we have been able to keep the pool and park open 4 days a week and every other weekend which has provided some relief. For the keiki, we put on movie nights on the grass in the summer, and had a very successful Halloween trick-or-treat night just last month.
