

## Tie Break Policy

### Race

Manitoba Dirt Riders Inc. (MDR) will employ the following in the event of a tie.

- Final results shall be based on the number of full laps completed. Where two or more riders have completed an equal number of laps, the results will be based on the time in which they completed the final lap.
- Where an event is stopped, the positions of the riders at the last check over the finish line, previous to the stop signal, shall be considered the finishing positions. The rider responsible for the stoppage will be placed last in the results.

### Series Championship

- The Series Championship will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in each class in which a rider competed in more than 3 events. Final positions will be based on total cumulative points for the race year, with the allowance of 1 drop race.
- In the event that two participants finish the year with the same number of points, the rider with the best overall finishes, excluding their drop race, will be awarded the position.
- If a tie remains, the races that both riders competed in will be reviewed, and the rider with the greatest number of laps will be awarded the position.
- If a tie remains, the lap times for both riders, in the races they both competed in, will be calculated, and the rider with the shortest cumulative time will be awarded the position.
- If a tie still remains, the tie shall be broken by the final placement, of the final race of the championship series.
