

## Instructions for finishing the Shop Hop 2017 Quilt (as shown on poster).

25 Shop Hop blocks are used in this quilt.

Finished quilt size: 61½" x 61½" • Finished block size: 8" x 8"

### Materials

(Yardages are based on 40" usable fabric width, after prewashing fabric and trimming selvages.)

1⅝ yds. Black Vertical (2TG1) for sashing strips and binding

¼ yd. Pebbly Tweedy (3TG2) for cornerstones

2 yds. Shop Hop 2017 Newspaper Print for border

4⅛ yds. for backing

### Cutting

From Black Vertical, cut:

- 7 strips, 2½" x 40", for double-fold binding
- 15 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 60 rectangles, 2" x 8½", for sashing strips

From Pebbly Tweedy, cut:

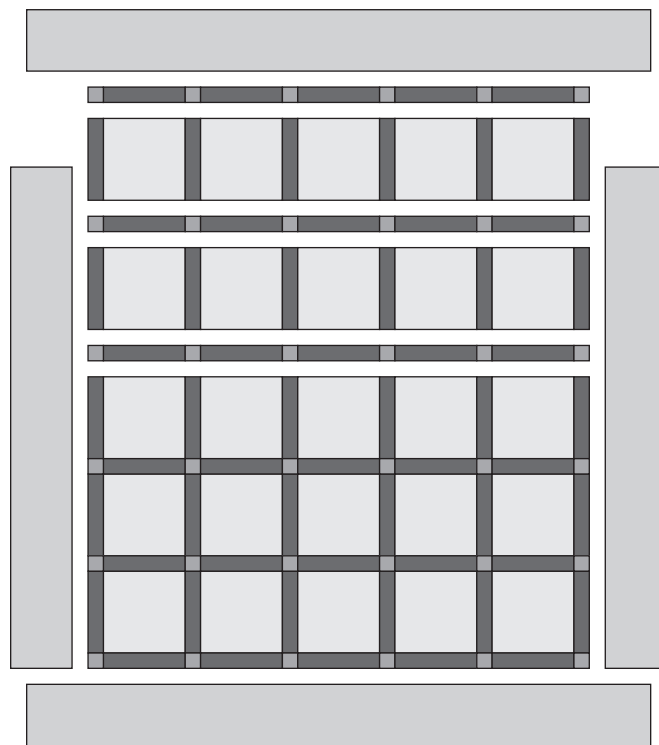
- 2 strips, 2" x 40"; crosscut 36 squares, 2" x 2", for cornerstones

From Shop Hop 2017 Newspaper Print, cut:

- 4 strips, 6½" x length of fabric, for borders (These are cut long, and will be trimmed to size later.)

### Quilt Top Assembly

1. Sew sashing strips and cornerstones, and sashing strips and Shop Hop blocks, together in rows as shown in the Quilt Assembly Diagram; then join rows together. Press all seams toward sashing strips.
2. Measure length of quilt top through center. Trim 2 border strips to this measurement, and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward border strips.
3. Measure width of quilt top, including borders just added, through center. Trim the remaining 2 border strips to this measurement and sew to sides of quilt. Press seams toward borders.

### Finishing

Layer quilt top, batting, and backing. Quilt as desired. Bind. Don't forget to sign and date your finished quilt.
