Donate: *Used hearing aids* (Starkey credits OH account for each used aid received); *school supplies:* play dough, crayons, color pencils, markers, erasers, pencil sharpeners, kids' scissors, pencil cases; white glue, dry erase markers & permanent markers; notebooks.

Donate: *Dental supplies:* toothbrush, brushing detection (or lack of) liquid & dental floss
